from the black sands of the rugged west coast to the majestic Taranaki maunga. Along the way, enjoy our cafes, restaurants, or local bars for a well-deserved break.




For art lovers, don't miss the Govett-Brewster Art Gallery/ Len Lye Centre, where the building is as breathtaking as the art within.

Prize for the vehicle that gets the most looks when out on the road, has to go to a Kenworth truck owned by Colin and Debbie James of Tokoroa.

That's because the truck isn't really a truck, but a barbecue trailer. And because it is a trailer it has to be towed – backwards. "We get comments about it all the time," says Colin of the trailer, which sports a full-sized Kenworth grille. "We are in the trucking business, so we get to hear other truckies talking to each other, and they are always commenting about spotting a scaled-down Kenworth truck going backwards!"

The story of the BBQ trailer goes back a few years now, when Colin was chatting to an engineer mate of his in Putaruru. He mentioned he always seemed to be hiring barbecues to feed forestry crews in the central North Island.

"We decided it would be good idea if my mate built us a trailermounted barbecue. What he came up with was a downsized truck cabin that still weighed 2.5 tonnes, and had a full-sized Western Star grille on its front."

A little later Colin's company Central Equipment Movers changed to Kenworth trucks, which prompted a Rotorua friend to change the BBQ's grille from Western Star to Kenworth. So now the trailer has its full-sized Kenworth grille that dominates its rear when it is being towed.





These days the trailer is also fitted with a flash Bluetooth stereo system and Narva lights. That's the result of the BBQ being borrowed by a mate to take on a fishing trip to Mokau, where one of the participants was a marketing manager with a company that sells the audio and lighting equipment.

"So now it has four to six deep cycle batteries on board that power the big stereo system and a whole lot of Narva lights. As a result I've got the trailer insured for \$25,000!"

When the special BBQ trailer is towed to Taranaki for Americarna, it is going to be parked at New Plymouth racecourse and used to cook up a storm for charity. Each side of the truck cabin's bonnet folds down to reveal a pair of barbecues.

"I'll probably bring the trailer down to Taranaki the week before Americarna," says Colin, who also intends entering two other vehicles – his 1978 Plymouth Fury state trooper sedan, and his wife Debbie's bright yellow1982 Checker taxi.

That's what New Plymouth's Ross Spranger has done with his vehicle, which will make its first official outing at the 2025 Americanna.

"It was hosing down in New Plymouth, but my mate spotted some blue sky, so we headed off. But the rain didn't stop. We wore wet weather gear and we had rubbish bags over the seats, but we got soaked. The rain didn't let up all the way to Hamilton, and there were huge amounts of water coming off all four tyres." The men decided to stay the night at a motel in Hamilton, and fortunately the next day dawned cloudless and sunny, and it didn't rain for the remainder of the event.

by trade, he fabricated the cabin in his shed and installed it on the vehicle's existing chassis.

Local firm Eagle Automotive created new seats and did the hood lining, and also supplied an attractive blue point, which Poss

lining, and also supplied an attractive blue paint, which Ross thinks is the first local use of a 2023 Ford F100 colour from USA. The C-Cab is powered by a 410 cubic inch big-block Chevy V8, and the transmission is a two-speed PowerGlide that has been modified to suit race conditions. Differential is a 9-inch Ford.

Ross describes his creation as a 1923 Chevy C-Cab delivery van, and he is looking forward to getting it registered and warranted in time for its first official outing at Americana 2025.

"And I won't even mind if there's a shower or two," he says of his beautiful creation with its closed-in cabin.







That's because after the big pillarless hardtop began to experience engine trouble during a journey back from an event in the South Island, it was discovered its V8 engine had run a bearing. That required an engine rebuild that ran perilously close to Americama's registration deadline.

But the big fix made it in time, allowing Susie and her husband Dean to once again participate in a favourite celebration of American motoring muscle.

During the repair, a few interesting things were discovered about the Cadillac, which has been owned by the Beaven family for about eight years. the bonnet," explains Dean. "But we discovered it actually has a 1962 390ci engine. And instead of the original Hydra-Matic three-speed automatic transmission, it has a Turbo 400 version. You live and learn, eh?"

All of which doesn't matter to Susie, who loves her Caddy no matter what is under its bonnet. "I'd always wanted a 1950 Mercury, but when we started looking around we came across the Cadillac, and my kids said she was definitely for me. She was, too. She's beautiful – both to drive and to look at."

The Coupe DeVille is a classic example of the post-war period of American motoring when big and flambouyant pillarless hardtop vehicles were all the rage, especially when they featured big tail fins, lots of chrome, and conical front bumper guards that were called bullet bumpers by some, and dagmars by others – a reference to the bosom of Dagmar, a TV personality of the 1950s.

All of which explains why Susie was reduced to tears by last year's announcement that the Coupe DeVille had named the Americarna Pick, and would feature on this year's programme cover and the T-shirts.

"It was a total shock," she recalls. "All those gorgeous cars participating in Americama, but mine got selected. It was amazing."

MECHANICAL - SANDBLASTING - PANEL & PAINT



Low rider vehicles are usually created from low-slung sedans or convertibles such as Chevy Impalas, right? Not so with Stratford enthusiast Todd Holland, who has built his low rider from America's most popular full-sized SUV, the Chevrolet Tahoe.

"Why not?" says Todd when explaining the reasoning behind his special low rider. "I figured there's a sea of low rider Impalas out there in New Zealand, but up until now there hadn't been any Tahoes. So I thought it would be fun to do something different."

In 2023 he purchased a 1996 Tahoe off a mate's father-in-law, and got stuck into low rider-ing it. Eight months later the project was completed in time for last year's Americarna, where it entertained the public via its ability to both lower its suspension and jack itself up onto three wheels - hence the vehicle's 3WHELN rego plate.

'Low and slow' is the motto for low rider vehicles thanks to the tradition of their owners cruising as slowly and smoothly as possible, and Todd's Tahoe certainly fits that mould. In many respects it is a stock standard SUV, powered by a 351 cubic inch small-block V8 with just a few minor changes including different headers and an MSD ignition system. The exhaust has also been upgraded to a larger stainless system for a bit more of an engine rumble.


Things are considerably more complex under the Tahoe's body, however. There are big hydraulic cylinders front and rear, linked to four pumps and a bank of batteries all located in the rear load area.

Todd owns two Stratford businesses – panel and paint company RE Automotive, and hydro-dipping company Fluid Coatings NZ - and as a result not only does the Tahoe feature sensational paintwork that 'pops' in sunlight, but special print graphics have been transferred to vehicle components that range from suspension arms to both sides of the bonnet, as well as to various parts of the interior.

Setting the vehicle off is a set of 100-spoke wire wheels shod with whitewall tyres. End result: an American vehicle that is a real looker, especially when going through its ability to either sit down on its backside or pop itself up at the flick of a switch.

Big SUVs such as the Tahoe definitely aren't normally part of the low rider scene in New Zealand. But back in 2023 when Todd Holland spotted a US Chevy Blazer low rider on display on the internet, that prompted him to wonder if it were possible to do the same in this country.

Now he has answered that question, to spectacular effect.
